

Pengelli Forest, Pembrokeshire

Acquisition of 162 acres of ancient, semi-natural woodland which is the largest block of its type in south-west Wales. The forest has an exceptional variety of woodland types including the scarce plateau alder wood. It is home to many rare plants and animals such as bastard balm, early dog violet, purple hairstreak butterfly and the dormouse. For management as a nature reserve,
