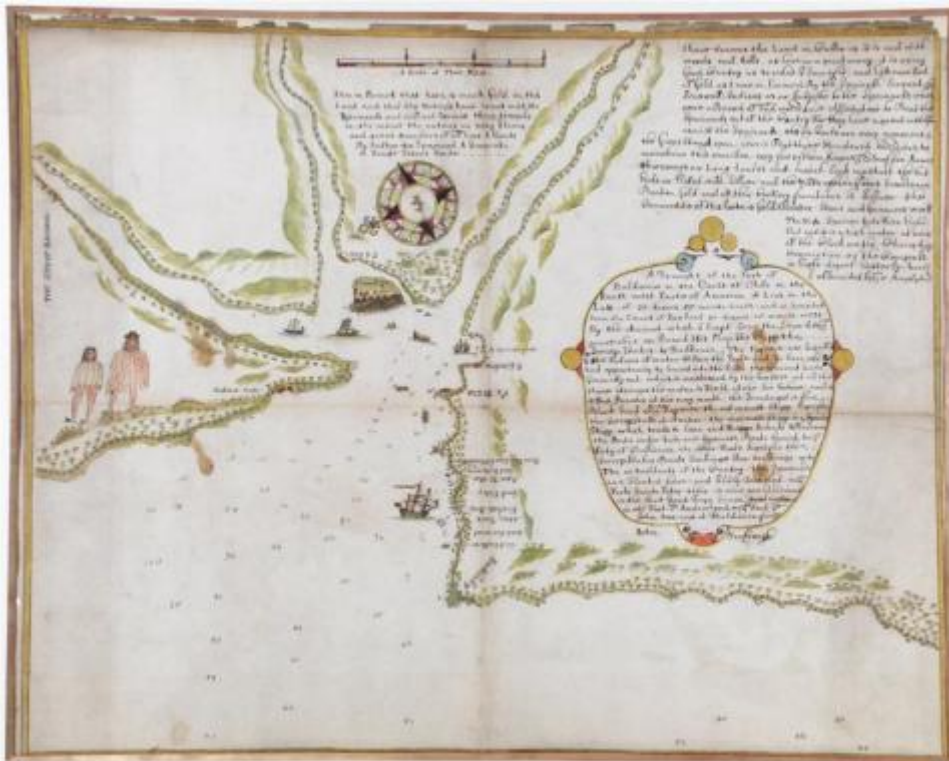


## Sir John Narbrough Journal and Charts
