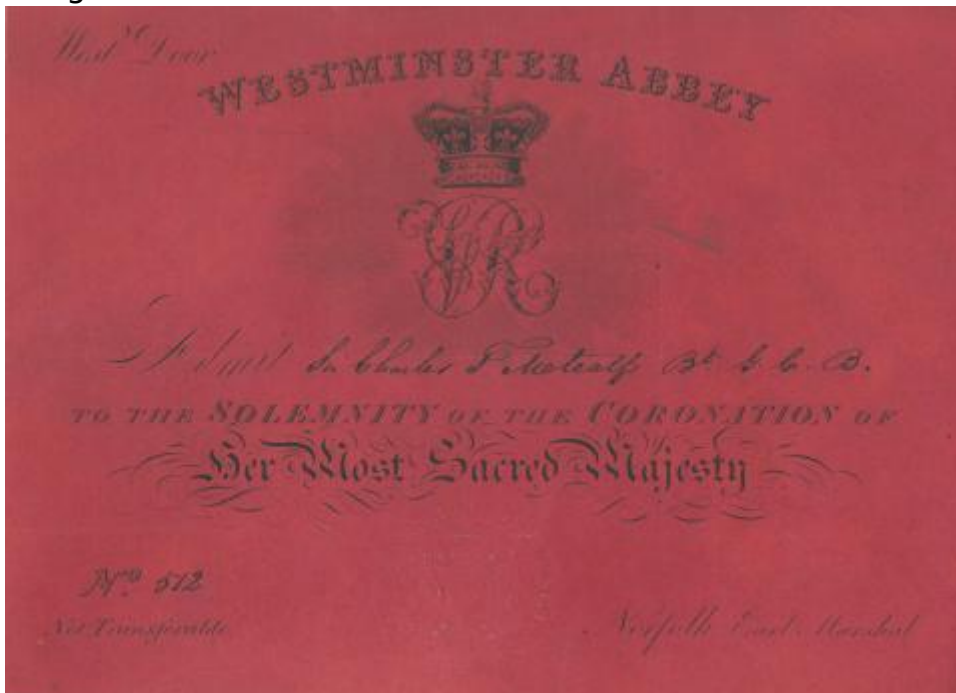


Monson Papers

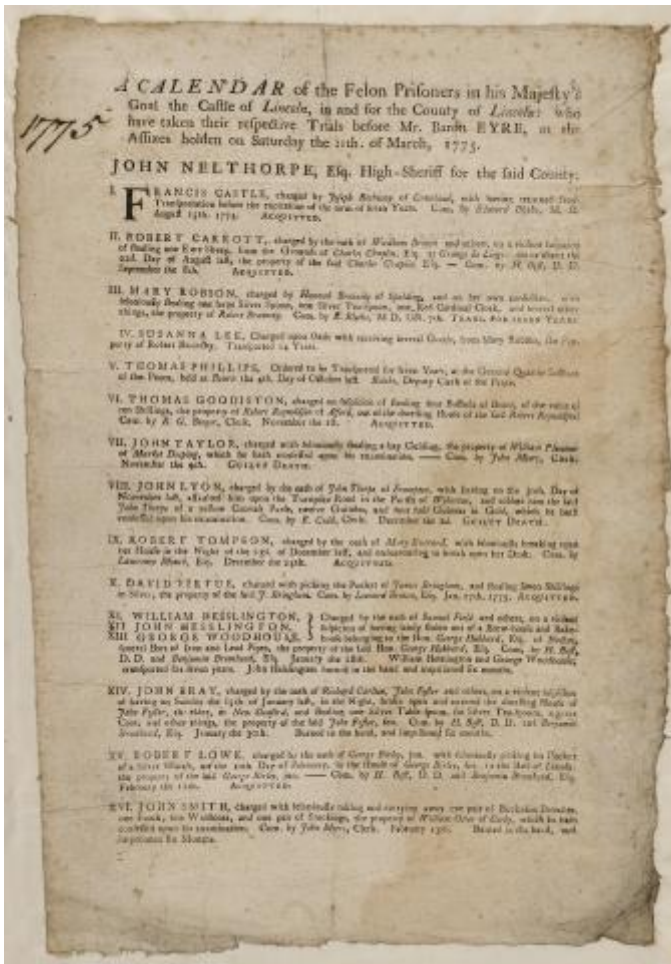

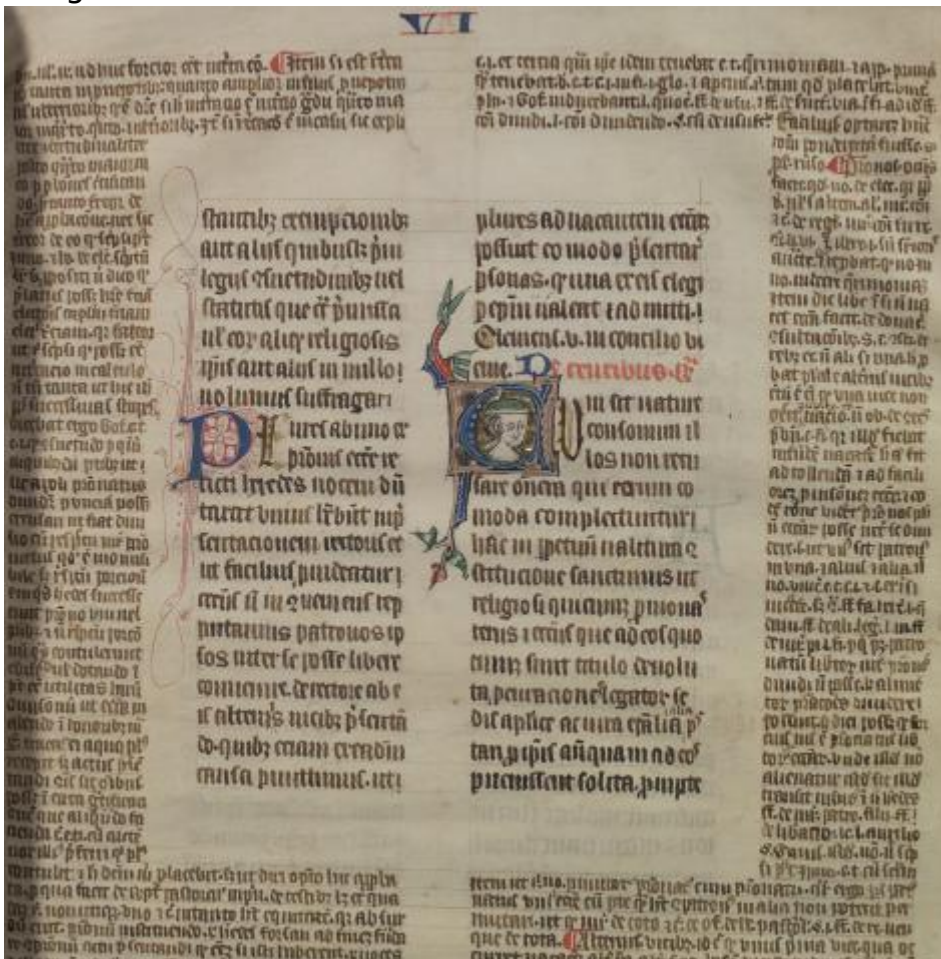


Invitation to Queen Victoria's coronation and letters documenting the outbreak of the American Civil War among treasures saved for the nation
